

Abstracts are invited in the following three categories:

1. Research papers (for oral or poster presentation)

Research papers related to normal and cesarean births, maternal and infant nutrition, breast feeding, methods of care used by midwives, etc. Details should include:

- Background, objectives in brief and concepts related to study -150 words
- Methodology including site, sample, design, tools and tests 100 words
- Findings and discussion 200 words
- Implications and conclusions 50 words

Note: Research studies using PTP or similar methods will not be considered. Only principal investigator will be allowed to present

2. Case and care papers for oral presentation by ANMs\LHVs and nurse midwives

These papers are related to care provided by a midwife to one mother or baby in the community or facility and at any stage of maternal or infant care. Only those dealing with challenging cases will be considered.

- Introduction about the case and problems\needs, treatment received if any -150 words
- Care given by the midwife including follow up 200 words
- Expression of the mother and family 50 words
- Challenges faced and suggestions for care 100 words
