AN OVERVIEW

Sanjay Gandhi Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences has been established under the State Legislature Act in 1983. It was created by the state of Uttar Pradesh as a Centre of excellence for providing medical care, education, and research of the highest order. The institute is situated in a 550 acres campus at Raebareli Road, 15 km from the main city. Lucknow is located about 500 km east of New Delhi and is the capital of Uttar Pradesh. It is rated among the top medical institutions in the country. A highly skilled and dedicated faculty provides quality education and state-of-the-art patient care and is involved in research that strives to meet the needs of society. The Institute awards DM, MCh, MD and MS degrees that are recognized by the National Medical Commission of India. It also offers a PhD program, a 2-year Master in Hospital Administration program (approved by the University Grant Commission) and one-year Post-Doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC), One-year Post-Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) & two years Post-Doctoral Advance Fellowship (PDAF) courses in different medical specialties. In addition, the Institute offers several non-degree/non-certificate training positions, such as Senior Resident (hospital services) and Junior Resident (Non-academic) positions in several medical specialties, a Senior Demonstrator program in Molecular Medicine & Biotechnology, Statistical Fellows in Biostatistics and Health Informatics and a Medical Physics Resident program in Radiotherapy. For para-medical training, the Institute has started Diploma, B.Sc. and M.Sc. courses in Medical Technology in different super-specialty subjects.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applications are invited for admission to MSc / Diploma courses in College of Medical Technology & Allied Health Sciences (CMT & AHSc) for academic year 2024- 25. The candidates must possess a requisite qualification recognized by the respective bodies that approve the qualifying courses as on 31st July 2024. The degrees from Departments / Institutions to which recognition has not been formally granted (for example: under consideration) will not be considered and candidature of applicants with such degrees may be rejected at any stage (including after admission if this fact comes to notice at that stage).

1	<p>Nationality: Only Indian nationals (irrespective of gender) are eligible. However, few seats are reserved for foreign nationals as detailed in the advertisement.</p>
2	<p>Age: For M.Sc. courses Minimum age should be 17 years and upper age limit is 35 years as on 31st July 2024.</p> <p>For Diploma courses Minimum age should be 17 years and upper age limit is 30 years as on 31st July 2024. Age relaxation to reserved category and sponsored candidates will be as per U.P. State Govt Rules and domicile of UP only.</p>
3	<p>Reservation: Reservation will apply as per U.P. Government rules for candidates having domicile of Uttar Pradesh only. Reserved category candidates having domicile other than Uttar Pradesh will be treated as General category candidates for all purposes.</p> <p>Reserved category candidates should produce an authentic certificate of their category, issued by a competent authority.</p>
4	<p>Sponsored Candidates: Departmental / sponsored candidates will have to take the same test to qualify for the course; however, a separate merit list will be prepared for sponsored candidates. The upper age limit may be relaxed for sponsored candidates.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. SGPGI will not pay any stipend during the entire training period as well as during the internship. b. The candidate should provide a certificate from the Government of U.P./sponsoring authority stating that: c. The candidate is a permanent employee of the sponsoring organization. d. She/he will be granted leave for the total duration of the course including internship. e. The candidate, after completing the course, will be suitably employed by the sponsoring organization to work in the specialty in which the training is provided. f. The sponsoring authority shall be responsible for payment of salary or any other emoluments to the candidate during the period of training. g. A sponsorship certificate should be attached with the application form, failing which the sponsorship will not be entertained.
5	<p>Application fee: Rs 1000 (Rs one thousand only) for all categories, payable by Net Banking, Debit / Credit card. Additional bank transaction charges may apply. The application fee is not refundable either in full or in part under any circumstances. Online application forms once submitted cannot be altered after the last date of submission.</p>

6	<p>METHOD OF SELECTION: Admissions to Diploma & M.Sc. courses are to be made through entrance examination conducted by the Institute. The Entrance Examination will be with a total of 100 marks (100 questions).</p> <p>An examination of 180 MINUTES duration, consisting of multiple-choice questions. Each question will have five options and each option should be marked as TRUE or FALSE. The candidate should select the correct answer from the given options in the questions. For each correctly marked response, 0.2 marks will be awarded. There will be no negative marking. No marks will be awarded if a response is not marked.</p> <p>In case of tie, In the event of two candidates securing identical total marks, the older candidate will be ranked higher.</p>
	<p>Counselling: All the qualified candidates those appeared in the Entrance test held on 29.07.2024 for admission/appointment to M.Sc. and Diploma courses, have to appear in Counselling as per following details.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All the candidates those secured minimum qualifying marks in the entrance examination and want to occupy the post/ position, is mandatory to appear IN PERSON at the counselling center. 2. It is mandatory for the candidates to be present at the counselling center on or before 12.30 PM on the said date. 3. Every participating candidate must be undergoing for biometric attendance followed by signature in the attendance register and mandatory document verification in front of the admission committee. 4. From the successfully verified candidates, a tentative ranking will be prepared. 5. From the above ranking list, candidates will be called to select the choices from all the available seats for that they are eligible. 6. After the successfully allotment seats to the verified candidates, they must submit the admission fee within the next one hour. After the receipt of the admission fee, their allotment to be confirmed and such candidates will be offered for the appointment letter. 7. All the candidates will be receiving the admission letter, preferably on the same day with their email id. Each candidate must join the post / positions within 15 days from the date of the appointment. 8. In case candidates will not attend the counselling on the said date and time, the candidature will be rejected with immediate effect. Although such candidates may get seats in future depending upon the available vacancy as per administrative decision.

9	Application fee once paid is not refundable either in full or in part under any circumstances
10	Print out of the online application form along with Identification cum Attendance card with your signature at specified places and paste self-certified passport size recent colored photograph at the appropriate places (whenever required).

HOW TO GET YOUR ADMIT CARD:

Eligible candidates can print their **Admit Card ONLINE** to appear in the entrance examination between prescribed dates using their email ID, password or as per the process mentioned on the web portal.

HOW TO KNOW YOUR RESULT:

- **Examination/ Result**

The list of eligible candidates called for counseling will be displayed on the Institute Notice Board as well as on the Institute's website.

The final result of entrance exam will be available on the Institute website / Institute notice

boards. Please refer to the institute website.

- **Procedure for scrutiny**

In case any candidate desires to get his/ her result scrutinized, he/she will require submitting a fee of Rs. 3000/- (Rs Three thousand only) online on the same portal of application form. The result will be made available in 15 days after the request is made. No request for scrutiny will be entertained after one week of publication of result.

- **Important Instructions**

Filling and submitting the application form only makes you eligible to appear in the entrance examination. Admission in the course is subject to verification of the essential documents of the qualified candidates at the time of counseling.

Selection of the students by the entrance examination conducted by the institute will be followed by counseling/Interviews as per institute norms. Candidates attending the interview cum seat counseling need to bring all original documents for verification and come prepared for fee payment and admission which will be done immediately as described below.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSION, FEE PAYMENT & LOCKING OF SEAT

1	The selected candidates after counseling are required to pay the first installment of the first year within the stipulated time. Their original certificates will be deposited with the Institute. Only after the receipt of the fees of the 1st semester, admission will be considered against that particular seat. Failure to complete registration formalities will lead to cancellation of the selection and the seat will be offered to the next wait-listed candidates.
2	Thereafter, the fee will have to be paid on a six-monthly basis, as per the academic schedule. Part payment of the term fee will not be entertained. The prescribed fee should be paid within 1 month of the commencement of each term.
3	The examination fee as prescribed will be notified before the examination.
4	All the candidates must pay the refundable Caution Money as specified in the fee chart. The same will be refunded when the student leaves the Institution after completion of the Course.
5	If the candidate wishes to opt for a seat in any course of the college, submission of fees and certificates is mandatory. If he or she wishes to appear in interviews related to other Institutions, the original documents will be issued as per withdrawal rules. A candidate can opt for only one course. No change in course after admission will be allowed under any circumstances. Candidates in employment must submit relevant documents at the time of counselling, if selected. These documents are mandatory for joining the course. (Proof of application through proper channel).

6	The examination fee is not refundable either in full or part under any circumstances
7	JOINING: If a candidate fails to join the course by the date stipulated in the selection letter, the offer shall automatically stand cancelled, and the seat will be offered to the next candidates in the waiting list in order of merit and Eligibility. At the time of joining, the selected candidates shall have to submit their original Matriculation certificate, Intermediate (10+2) passing certificate/ B.Sc. passing certificate, caste & domicile certificate in case of reserved category candidate, Migration Certificate and relieving certificate in case of sponsored candidates, and certificate of good conduct by two gazette officers.
8	MEDICAL EXAMINATION: No candidate will be permitted to join a course unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Medical Board shall be final.
9	FEE: Each student will have to pay the following fees inclusive of tuition, library, laboratory, examination fees, etc.

Other Important details	
1	PAYMENT OF FEES: Fees for the first instalment will be payable at the time of joining, 2nd instalment in January and that for subsequent years in July & January or within 15 days from the start of the session/ semester. The candidates will not be permitted to join the session/course without payment of the requisite fee.
2	DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Students admitted to the courses shall be required to perform such work as may be assigned to them and are necessary in the legitimate interest of patient care, teaching, training, research and in Emergency services as and when required.
3	DURATION OF THE COURSE: Overall, the total duration for Diploma course of Diploma in Telemedicine & Digital Health is 01 year. The M.Sc. Courses have 4 semesters with 1.5 years of didactic and practical followed by 06 months of Research project/Dissertation. The course curriculum and duration of the courses in hours are provided with respective courses in the ‘Courses’ section of the website in a short while at www.cmtsgggi.org . The entire curriculum is split into semesters of 6 months’ duration each, and semester examinations will be performed on a 6 monthly basis.
4	The maximum permissible duration of courses (inclusive of internship) – M.Sc. courses- 04 Years Diploma courses- 05 years
5	SALARY: No salary will be paid during the course.
6	HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION: The hostel facility is extended to outstation candidates, but not guaranteed since it is subject to availability as per Institute norms. In case of continued poor progress, the students may be asked to leave the hostel.
7	LEAVE ENTITLEMENT: The students will be normally entitled to following leaves (subject to pandemic conditions and change in teaching roster) 1. Winter Break: 07 days in December 2. Summer Break: 21 days in June 3. Sick Leave: 10 days /year 4. Other leaves: subject to achieving 80% attendance in theory classes and practical individually which is essential to be allowed to appear in the annual examination. Deficiency in attendance, if any, is to be made up in the vacations.
	LEAVING THE COURSE / WITHDRAWAL RULES: a. Students registered for and admitted to a course, desirous of obtaining their original documents from the Principal / Dean to attend interviews elsewhere, should have deposited the 1st semester year fees as mentioned above. b. Students who fail to inform their decision to continue or withdraw from the
