FCCS is an internationally renowned two-day comprehensive course by Society of Critical Care Medicine (SCCM) USA addressing fundamental management principles for the first 24 hours of critical care. The FCCS Curriculum is intended to introduce principles important in the initial care of critically ill/injured patients to physicians, physicians-in-training, nurses, and other healthcare providers who may or may not be skilled in critical care but who must care for such patients during early stabilization and in anticipation of the arrival of an intensivist, specialist or pending transfer of the patient to a tertiary center.

This course contains: 16 Didactic lectures, 4 Case-based skill stations, Pre- and post-tests, FCCS Support textbook, Certificate of successful course completion.

To receive the certificate of successful completion course participants must attend all didactic lectures, successfully complete all skill stations, and achieve a score of 70%

or higher on the course post-test. **It approximately takes about three months to get the certificate from FCCS USA Headquarters.**
