The Registration of Birth & Death Act: Principles & Practices

- **Objective:** To sensitize & enhance knowledge of practical aspect of an Act which provide for the regulation of Registration of Births & Deaths and for matters connected therewith.

- Description: Registration of birth is a right of every child and is the first step towards establishing her/his legal identity. It is compulsory to report births and deaths to the Registrar of Births and Deaths under the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 (Act No. 18 of 1969.). Births and deaths are registered only at the place of their occurrence. It is the responsibility of the officer in charge or any person authorised by her/him to report the births and deaths that occur in hospitals, nursing homes, health centres etc. to the Registrar of Births and Deaths of the concerned area. Health care workers who have attended or were present at the time of birth or death are duty bound to notify the concerned Registrar about the occurrence of the event.
