The prescribed period of teaching and or research experience should be 3, 3 10 or 14 years and cannot include only administrative experience.



Minutes of the meeting held on 4.8.2017 to identifying possible factors responsible for reduction in extramural grants and dwindling number of Ph.D. students and for enhancing the quality of research at the Institute

Prof. Sanjay Behari did not attend the meeting as he was abroad. Prof. R.N.Mishra, Former Dean, apprised of the reasons identified by the meeting held on July 17, 2015. Dr. Amita Agrawal, presented the minutes of meeting held with the Director on August 17, 2016. The factors identified by the above two committees were deliberated upon and out of which following factors were identified for further consideration.

- 1. Lack of a conducive atmosphere encouraging research as doing research is not considered to be important.
- 2. Lack of recognition of research projects as a criteria for assessment promotion.
- 3. Lack of critical mass of researchers, to discuss ideas and problems in research.
- 4. Lack of protected time for Research.
- 5. Easy access to intramural grants which were initially thought to be used as seed money to generate extramural grants has over period of time lost its purpose. Many faculty members now bank on it as the main funding support and they are not putting in effort to seek competitive extramural grants.
- 6. Lack of ideas and inability to formulate hypothesis-driven research questions. Most faculty members are doing observational research with relatively low impact.
- 7. Difficulty in utilization of research funds especially in purchase of equipments and recruitment of manpower in research.
- 8. Lack of experimental facility in the current animal house.
- 9. Less extramural funds means less Ph.D. students.
- 10. Ph.D. students are not paid monthly stipend, till it comes

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from the funding agency.

The possible solution to improve the research suggested by the committee were deliberated by the Academic Board and accepted the following for further consideration:

- 1. Research capacity building in faculty
 - A. Workshop on Research methodology for faculty.
 - B. Monthly lecture by eminent research from across the country.
 - C. Research CGR by in-house faculty twice a month
 - D. Encourage collaboration with other institutions or laboratories and in between different departments of the Institute.
- E. The Academic Board suggested that Institute my organize "Research Show Case" once in a year and may award appreciation to the departmentswith meritorious research publications.

(For properly implementing the points (A to E a faculty needs to be identified as Nodal Officer)

- Provision of protected time for research (once a week or a week every month).
- The faculty may be encouraged to generate the grants so that they can publish the articles in the indexed journals to fulfill the mandatory requirement of MCI regarding publications for promotion.
- Recruitment of more basic scientists as faculty.
- Provision of a lab manager for administrative work of the research lab. The members felt that we cannot create such type of posts at our Institute since it does not exist in AIIMS. The HOD's concerned may allot doing this type of work to the available staff only.
- More autonomy to researches in utilizing grants money. Purchase procedures to be made simpler on lines of CSIR. Prof. S.K. Sarin suggested that for research grants CSIR guidelines are very simple and most of the Institutions are using CSIR guidelines. Institute may adopt the same for SGPGI also. Academic Board directed the Faculty Incharge Research to study the CSIR guidelines and put up a detailed proposal for placing it in Finance Committee/Governing Body for further decision.
- Ease of outsourcing for NGS/Exome/DNA sequencing or other needs as that ensures quality rather than doing them in-house. Academic Board decided that an inhouse committee may study this and prepare a proposal.

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 Improvement of animal house facility. The chairman suggested that we have enough infrastructures for animal house. The faculty members while preparing the proposal involving the animal house in research purpose may first visit the animal house and then accordingly write their projects.
• The present system of granting intramural grants to the
 faculty is to continue. Improve availability of online library resources. Academic Board approved giving facility to pay publication charges if applicable for papers accepted in journals with impact factor above 3.0 from Academic Accounts of the Institute.
 Ceiling in number of projects that can be submitted to IEC should not include projects that have not yet been
funded but only submitted. • Use of high end equipment procured by department (Institute or through research grants) should be encouraged but it should be supported by the Technician to run the machine howard office how
to run the machine beyond office hours. Further the faculty members who want to use it must discuss with user department and purchase consumable for his /her experiments. It was also felt that the equipment should stay in the parent department that has procured it since the department will look after its unkeep and
the department will look after its upkeep and maintenance. Prof. Amit Agrawal, CMS clarified that posting of technician is responsibility of concerned HOD, the HOD may earmark the duty as deemed fit.


